JACE

(manically)

listen man, I don't want to make a scene, just give me your phone, wallet, cash, whatever you got.

Tony looks around to see if there are any witnesses, but no one is around.

TONY

Aw come on man!

He hands Jace his phone, wallet, and keys.

Jace stuffs them into his pocket.

TONY

That's all I got.

The Homeless Woman arrives at her encampment. It is under a tree. She has a small tent, with junk strewn around it.

There is a dog next to her tent, laying down, tied to the tree.

The dog's ears perk up and it stands.

HOMELESS WOMAN

get you a treat!

The dog barks and wags its tail.
