The film projector is turned on in the dark, and the film starts playing. $\,$

LEON (V.O.)

I like coming to the theater at night.

While the film is playing, Leon (28) walks to his seat in the dark theater.

LEON (CONTINUED)

I don't really care about what kind of movie I'm watching right now.

On the screen, a old Hong Kong movie named Aces Go Places is playing.

LEON (CONTINUED)

I just think watching movie is an interesting thing to do...

Leon is watching the movie in the dark, and the light caused by reflection in his eyes is flickering.

LEON (CONTINUED)

...because it allows me to go through lives, lives that are different from mine.

3 EXT. STREET - MORNING

Karen is standing next to the crossroad and waiting for the signal light.

KAREN (V.O.)

I've been having similar dreams recently...

Karen walks across streets.

KAREN (CONTINUED)

...or they're more like "experiences"

LEON (V.O.)

Because they are too real to be dreams.

Leon is leaning against a street lamp and smoking.

LEON (CONTINUED)

I've been searching for something in those "dreams."

Leon is walking on the street filled with neon lights.

BEGIN TITLES

SPLIT SCREEN ENDS.

7 EXT. ALLEY - NIGHT

FADE IN:

A Drop of blood drips to the wet concrete pavement.

Leon, in black hooded raincoat, raises his left hand and looks at his watch. It's 4 in the morning. The back of his left hand is bleeding from an incised wound.

LEON

I've already wasted too much time on you. I hate to work overtime.

Leon takes out a black handkerchief from his coat pocket and laps it around his wounded hand. Then he takes out a gun from behind his back.

A mid-aged man in grey hoodie is lying on the ground. His eyes are wide with fear, and his nose and mouth are bleeding. Blood has covered up his face like red dye.

Leon points the gun at the mid-aged man and fires.

3 INT. OPERATING ROOM - DAY

A white mask turns red with a splash of blood.

Karen, in surgical gown, passes micro scissors to one of her assistants.

KAREN

Clean surgery field and give me

aneurysm clips.

Karen is swiftly finishing last part of the surgery.

The patient appears in stable condition. Ready to conclude CPB.

Sitting against the wall, Karen looks at the clock on the wall. It is 4 in the afternoon. She stands up, walks out of the operating room and closes the door.

CASHIER

The total is gonna be...

Without hearing out, Karen hands the cashier a twenty-dollar bill.

The cashier tries to give change, but Leon has already stepped out of the convenience store and walks to his left.

12 INT. RESTAURANT - DAY

Karen stands in front of the counter of a Chinese restaurant.

KAREN

A Char siu rice to go, thank you!

Karen anxiously looks at the clock on the wall. It is 5:30 in the afternoon.

WAITER

Your Char siu rice, miss...

As soon as Karen get the food, she hands a twenty-dollar bill to the waiter.
