there protesting because the

OFFICER LANCE

Majority of our police officers do  
a good job. As an officer, when I  
take off the uniform, I still have  
to abide by the same things I tell  
everybody else. I get nervous if I  
get stopped by a police officer.  
Its a natural reaction,  
unfortunately the media stirs a lot  
of that to make it seem like it's  
more rampant than it is.

TAYLOR BROWN

It is rampant. What if I was white? Would I have gone through this harassment? There are far more encounters sir... I fear for my life. What if you shot me? Yeah! It means nothing just another headline... maybe not today

OFFICER LANCE

They are police officers that are professional, that are courteous, that go unreported, than go bad. All we can do is be responsible for what we do. If you get stopped, listen to directions they give you, do what you're told to do, even if you don't agree with why you're being stopped. The time to make that argument is not then what you do is comply. When you start to banter back and forth it raises suspicion and anxiety. You don't want that. You want everyone to remain calm. That's why there are complaints procedures out there for you to address those complaints

TAYLOR BROWN

Thank you for your sympathy, the struggle didn't just start today. My parents protested against it. Its everywhere systemic racism, the bank, schools, name it. I have daughter and here I am protesting for same shit hoping my daughter don't do same.

TAYLOR BROWN

(perturb)

I'm tired physically and emotionally, having to be treated like a nobody because of the color of my skin. That is why we will stop at nothing protesting to end police brutality and demand for racial justice.

OFFICER LANCE

I understand the protests, and its intent to protest peacefully and send a message with the hope that nobody gets hurt that the messaging and the protests and the rallies is not being lost by virtue of these people who were looting, rioting and being violent.

TAYLOR BROWN

It's hard, because on one hand I don't believe in riots, looting and violence, but on the other hand, when is enough, enough? To be black in America, you have to endure; You have to fear the police. You have to hope someone recorded your compliance because you may no longer be around to defend yourself.

I have black people in my life: my beautiful wife, son, in-laws. I fear for their lives too I pray one day they don't get to encounter the bad cop or the bad guy.
