Medium shot of REPORTER DALE KITCHENS **[GREEN SCREEN]**

REPORTER DALE KITCHENS “We have exclusive footage from a murder scene in the North West area of the city from several days ago. We received this footage of the bodies of a man and a woman who were found by a passerby. The man looked to have a broken neck and the woman appeared to be severely burned although her clothing was not. We also have a video copy of a note found at the scene. It reads **“If a man commits adultery with the wife of his neighbor, both the adulterer and the adulteress shall surely be put to death.**”

SCENE 4

1. INT. NEWSTATION – DAY [GREEN SCREEN]

Reporter Karla Criswall

Reporter, KARLA CRISWAL, is sitting at the news anchor desk.
KARLA CRISWALL “The gruesome remains of a female and male have been found in the woods, south of the city. The cause of their death is unknown. Dental records were used to make a positive I.D. and the deaths are now being ruled a homicide on the strength of a note, found at the scene. The message, written in blood, states “CHEATERS ARE HOME WRECKERS WHO SHOULD PAY FOR THEIR SINS”. Authorities have confirmed that both victims are married but they are withholding the names of the victims until their spouses are notified.”

Scene 10

INT. RUN DOWN MOTEL - MOTEL ROOM - NIGHT

REPORTER KARLA CRISWALL “A desiccated body was found today and appears to have died under very mysterious circumstances. A note was left

that appears to have been written in blood, stating that the man died because he was having an affair with unknown woman.”

SCENE 30

INT. MOTEL ROOM – NIGHT

DALE KITCHENS “Another man and woman were found dead in a motel on Nineteenth Street. According to a note found by the investigators the man was another victim of the “Spirit’s Revenge” killer. The man was married and again apparently not to the woman he was with. In other news the police are investigating a shooting that left two people dead and three more wounded. A spokesperson for the department said that they have no apparent motive and that they will be...”

SCENE 49

INT. RUN DOWN MOTEL - NIGHT

REPORTER DALE KITCHENS “A married woman was found dead and her husband denies any involvement. The cause of death has yet to be determined. Once again, no DNA was left behind but there was a note stating that she was an adulterer.”

SCENE 56

INT. ZOEY’S ACCOUNTING FIRM - RECEPTION DESK – DAY

Jill is looking at a news story on her computer online.

NEWS ANCHOR “We still know very little about these strange killings but the police are telling us that they are doing all that they can to apprehend the person or persons responsible. In a statement released today they recommend that if you don’t have to go out, don’t.”

SCENE 64 **GREEN SCREEN**

INT. ZOEY'S ACCOUNTING FIRM - ZOEY'S OFFICE - DAY

KARLA CRISWALL (To camera) "Another couple have been found in an advanced state of decomposition. The cause of death is, again, unknown but the remains resemble the bodies of the "Spirit's Revenge" victims. The police are working every possible lead and there has even been a \$250,000 reward offered for the arrest of the culprit or culprits involved."

(To DALE) "Dale, so far the detectives are dumbfounded. Is there any advice you wanna give to the public. Other than, if you are cheating, you need to stop."

DALE KITCHENS (To KARLA) "No, Karla, I think that just about covers it.

(To CAMERA) I do wish to add a footnote to our story. I don't know if it's based on these mysterious killings or not, but there has been an increase in the amount of divorces filed recently."

KARLA CRISWALL "Interesting statistic."
