THE PLAY

This is a play about the clash between ambition and principles. Although the setting is politics, the basic conflict is probably a universal one.

ROLES

STEPHEN BELLAMY -25 +Press sec retary for Presidential candidate Governor Morris, a very complex and challenging character, confident, arrogant, admired and charming

PAUL ZARA – Late 40's +, Campaign manager for Governor Morris. Idealistic yet realistic, somewhat ruthless in pursuit of campaign goals.

MOLLY – 19+, an intern on the Morris campaign, confident, almost brazen, goes directly for what she wants.

BEN-early 20's+, deputy press secretary for the Morris cmmpaign, somewhat niave, yet ambitious, hard working, somewhat in awe of others.

TOM DUFFY-late 40's-early 50's, campaign manager for the rival Pullman campaign, likeable, but basically morally deficient, good salesman

IDA HOROWICZ – mid 30's-50's a traveling political reporter for the *New York Times*. ambitious, fairly hard nosed, but amiable. can play with the big boys.

FRANK- any age a reporter for the *Los Angeles Times*, conscientious, sincere,

WAITER any age. (probably what you want to make him)
